The Area Wildfire Manager provides support, coordination, evaluation, and oversight of wildland fire operations, mitigation, administrative, and training applications pertaining to wildland fire suppression, management, and control within the communities of Arrowhead, Beaver Creek, Bachelor Springs, and Bachelor Gulch.

This position requires strong leadership abilities, communication skills, and organizational knowledge, as well as strong program management skills, including critical thinking. Must be able to read, write and speak the English language proficiently enough to communicate effectively. A High School Diploma or equivalent is required, as well as ten years of experience in the fire service or relatable field.

Key AWM Candidate Attributes

 Rigorous fieldwork will require above average physical performance, endurance and superior conditioning. Duties include demands of strenuous activities in emergencies under adverse environmental conditions and over extended periods of time

- Work requires prolonged standing, walking over uneven ground, and recurring bending, reaching, lifting, carrying of items weighing over 50 pounds, and shared lifting and carrying of heavier items. The operation of some specialized fire equipment can place extended physical stress on incumbent during fire activities.
- May require working long hours (occasionally up to 16 hours per day) in an outdoor setting and performing strenuous manual labor. The ability to live in primitive accommodations such as temporary camps, tents, and trailers.
- Incumbent is subject to medical examination and must pass the work capacity test for arduous positions.
